Early English and Phonic

Awareness



To begin with, Giraffe Class are going

to be learning about stories with patterned language using 'We're going on a Bear Hunt'. In non fiction we are learning about postcards looking at meerkat mail and Paddington's post - look out for a postcard heading your way soon. In poetry we are learning about creating poetry using the senses, exploring tap the magic tree and nature for our ideas. This term our Phonic Awareness will start to consider initial sounds and blending and segmenting.



Early Science

We will be learning about animals and their habitats looking at where animals live, how to look after animals and what they need to survive in the wild.



Early PSHE

Early PSHE this term, we are learning about being and keeping healthy. We will explore different foods and ways to keep ourselves healthy.



Discovery

Our focus in Discovery this term is on RE and special stories. We will be exploring the different creation stories and looking at Noah's Ark.





Early Maths

During the first term, we will be revisiting our number work. Pupils will experience joining in with a

range of number songs through interaction with objects and using symbols to fill in gaps. We will be using Numicon. We will be exploring numbers including multiplication and division, measurement and space, shape and colour. We are using Numicon in a variety of multisensory learning experiences including number songs and rhymes and we explore other mathematical concepts through play-based learning.

Physical Development

The theme this term is team games then gymnastics. We will explore problem solving skills and working



together, and then after half term we will explore moving over and under equipment working on fundamental movements.

Early Computing

In Early Computing we will be looking at how things work and giving directions and commands - using technology to complete games and make items move.



<u>Creative</u>

In Creative lessons we will be creating our own textiles looking at Peruvian textiles focusing on



patterns and colours. After half term we will be cooking; looking at making food for special events including hot cross buns and Easter bread and eggs.

<u>Other</u>



Your child will also have the opportunity to participate in a range of play and adult -led activities linked to our theme such as imaginative play, water / sand play,



stories, puppets, role play with dolls, animal and number songs and rhymes, sensory mark making, playdough, inset puzzles and jigsaws, sorting, counting, creative activities, cooking, computer activities, using the interactive whiteboard, iPad and Magic Carpet and outdoor play.

Soft play and the Sensory room will be accessed weekly to provide opportunities for PPP targets to be completed and sensory diets fulfilled. **Outdoor learning** Please send in wellies, waterproofs and spare clothes for your child as there will always be access to water and messy play activities outside to meet sensory needs and EHCP targets We will be going out in all weathers where safe to do so, so please send in these outdoor clothing items as they are required to enable full access to the curriculum. Thank you if you have already sent some in.

Hydrotherapy will be on a Tuesday afternoon, kit will be required. **Physical Development** will be on a Thursday afternoon, kit will be required.

Music will be on Monday mornings and after half term we will have Del the music man to deliver sessions.
