




# Tiger Autumn Newsletter

## Theme: Time Travellers

### Early Maths

This term during our number lessons we will be learning about place value, counting, number recognition, addition and subtraction. We will also investigate length and height and Money. There will be a weekly focus on Number such as counting, recognition of digits and ordering.



### Early English and Phonics

We will explore shape poems in Poetry. Non-chronological reports will focus on how to follow recipes. Narrative will explore Fantasy Worlds. We will offer a variety of activities to develop pencil grip and control and follow the Happy Handwriting scheme throughout the week. Phonics sessions will follow the Little Wandle SEND scheme.



### Early Science

Our Science topic this term looks at Animals, Plants and the Environment.



### Early Computing

This term we will be exploring using everyday technology. We will also explore using technology to communicate.



### Early PE

PE this term is Dance for the first half of the term and an introduction to gymnastics for the second half of the term.



### Early PSHE

In PSHE our topics are identifying and expressing feelings. We will also explore playing and working together.



### Early DT and Early Art

In Early DT we will design, make and evaluate a moving vehicle.

In Early Art we will investigate sparks and flames. Our focus is Damien Hurst.



### Discovery

This term we are learning about the great fire of London and the Gunpowder Plot. We will explore events and use a range of mediums to create pictures/recipes ect related to the historical events.



### Other

**Soft play** will be accessed weekly to support various aspects of the curriculum as well as providing opportunity for PPP targets to be completed and sensory diets fulfilled.

**Swimming** will be on Friday morning (kit will be required).

**PE** is on a Tuesday morning-kit required.
