






How it Works

<p>Communicate with someone at home about what you have taken part in at school today, using the school diary as prompts. Is there anything that you have really enjoyed?</p> <p>★</p>	<p>Help to look after an indoor plant at home. Think of all of the things that a plant needs, can you keep it healthy? What have you had to consider?</p> <p>★</p>	<p>Spend time in your garden and be mindful of your surroundings. What can you smell, hear and see? How is it different to the Spring/ Summer?</p> <p>★</p>	<p>Practise a new skill that would support your independence with dressing. Can you fasten buttons and zips? Maybe you could try to tie shoelaces? These are super skills to have!</p> <p>★</p>	<p>When you are next at the supermarket, have a look at all of the different jobs that people do. Can you see any of the roles that we have talked about in class?</p> <p>★</p>
<p>Read a different type of literature that you haven't read before, such as a comic or poetry. Share what you did and didn't enjoy with someone at home.</p> <p>★★</p>	<p>Explore a variety of coins. Notice the colour, shape and size. Can you see the number on them? How many different types of coin are there? Add 2 coins together, how much is there altogether?</p> <p>★★</p>	<p>Do a good deed, donate some items that you no longer use/need to charity. Take it to a charity shop and find out what charity they support.</p> <p>★★</p>	<p>Try to engage in physical activity 3 times a week. A walk, a yoga session online, even dancing to music, anything that encourages you to move.</p> <p>★★</p>	<p>Choose a new job that you can learn to do at home. Perhaps folding clothes and putting them away? You could maybe change the bed sheets. Anything new you would like to do!</p> <p>★★</p>
<p>Explore some autumnal craft activities and see if there are any that you would like to create in school as part of our sessions on instructions. Are you able to follow the instructions to create an example for class?</p> <p>★★★</p>	<p>Can you find out some interesting news from an appropriate sources such as BBC Newsround and email it to the class email?</p> <p>★★★</p>	<p>Create an autumnal collage of anything that you like. It could be a mix of natural items that you collect on a walk, with pictures of clothes that you like to wear at this time of the year.</p> <p>★★★</p>	<p>Can you create your own sensory circuit with songs and exercises?
