






How it Works

<p>Share a fantasy story. Look at the pictures, follow the words and choose your favourite characters. Can you predict what might happen next? Can you join in with any repeated phrases?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★</p>	<p>This term we are growing plants. Can you try and grow a plant of your own—maybe some cress or a bean indoors? What changes do you notice as it grows? What does it need to grow and stay healthy?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★</p>	<p>Help to keep your home clean and tidy by doing a household job. Maybe put the washing on the line, or vacuum?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★</p>	<p>Think of all the things that we do to keep the different parts of our body clean and healthy. Can you list them?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★</p>	<p>This term we are going to be 'Time Travellers'. Can you go out and explore somewhere significant from the past? <p>Participate in matching sounds within the environment with their object or picture. Extension: Can you identify items that start with the letter 's'</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>	<p>Visit a local shop and use money to buy an item, practicing your money handling skills. Can you count different coins? Can you group different coins based on their size, colour or value?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>	<p>Take part in an exercise activity. May go swimming or perhaps you would like to have a brisk walk. Do you feel energised afterwards?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>	<p>Prepare a healthy meal, include something that you haven't tried before. Be adventurous: you may be surprised!</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>	<p>Find leaves and flowers to make a plant-inspired picture. Can you describe what you find? Can you compare different leaves you find—which is bigger, crunchier, brighter etc.?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>
<p>Use instructions to make a craft item. For example an Autumn wreath, a Halloween decoration or a Christmas card.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★★</p>	<p>Cut paper or card into circles, triangles and squares. Can you use them to make a pattern? You could make a repeating pattern or fit shapes closely together in a mosaic.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★★</p>	<p>Find some photos of 'special' people to you and send to school to share with your friends. Can you identify 'who', 'what doing', 'what' and 'where' for example: 'Mum drinking juice in the garden'.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★★</p>	<p>Can you learn a new dance? Either one that you can copy, or if you are feeling really adventurous why not create your own?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★★</p>	<p>When visiting different places this term can you look out for any features or objects from the past; and take pictures of them?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★★</p>
