This could be swimming, football, dancing or having a walk in the local area. How does it make you feel? Can you move at different speeds? Can you feel your breathing and heart beating faster?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★</p>	<p>We will be making a moving vehicle this term in Design and Technology - can you go on a 'vehicle hunt'? What colours can you see? Where might they be going? Can you find any wheels on items around your house?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★</p>
<p>Find a recipe to make together and practice your cooking skills. Look at what ingredients you need and the method you need to follow. Can you follow handwashing routines and safe kitchen rules?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>	<p>Can you line up some of your favourite toys and do some simple counting? Or have a go at grouping them in to big and small or by colour.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>	<p>Play a family game together-e.g. Snakes and Ladders. Encourage turn taking, waiting for a turn.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>	<p>Go to the park and use the playground equipment. Can you climb the bars? Can you climb the ladder? Can you move yourself on the roundabout? Can you go higher on the swing? Take pictures to share with your friends in class.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>	<p>Can you create a 'firework' piece of artwork? What colour will you use? Can you use different tools such as felt-tip pens, pencil crayons, wax crayons or paint?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★</p>
<p>Can you collect some things that remind you of autumn such as leaves and conkers. Can you describe these using key words with your family. You could talk about colours, shapes and textures of these items.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★★</p>	<p>Have a go at using some everyday technology with an adult. Think about what we have been exploring in our computing lessons. E.g. turning on the washing machine. Helping make your toast of a morning.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★★</p>	<p>Can you create a picture of a face showing one of the emotions such as happy or sad add pictures off the internet that make you feel this emotion e.g. iPad for happy, rainy days for sad.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★★★</p>	<p>Can you try and get ready independently?
